

LuLu LoLo - Fanning Cares Away

Fans have long been a fashion accessory and a fan's gesture can convey many emotions. A performer carrying a fan (either purchased or handmade) along Nieuwstraat for 30 minutes in the late afternoon or early evening between the hours of 14:00-16:00 will perform a series of emotional gestures and movements:

Walking fanning themselves.

Sitting covering their eyes and then quickly revealing their eyes to survey the scene and quickly recovering their eyes.

Standing and then pacing, slapping their fan first impatiently then angrily.

Leaning and cooling themselves with the fan.

Improvise a fan gesture.

Running in a hurry while fanning themselves and looking around.

Sitting posing the fan as a body ornament in their hair, against their chest, and on their face.

Final Gesture: Strolling fanning themselves smiling.

Walking for half an hour in de Nieuwstraat with a fan, fanning, standing still, windy weather, starting by standing before a small, rather new antiques shop, where, o coincidence, over 3 old fans in the window

running in the street, nobody looks, nobody surprised, a bride, a broom with guests just arriving, I am fanning and watching these slowly walking people in their smart clothes

something I lean against a wall or sit on a bank or seat in the street, doing different things with the fan, posing, hiding my face behind the red fan, holding it as a skirt, behind my back, throwing it from my right hand to my left hand and so on and higher up into the sky

You can do many things rather unnoticed, only noticed by other performers, who are walking or sitting or eating in that same street
